- The development of a management policy, regulation, data system or other task that significantly enhances the economy, efficiency and effectiveness of an agency or company's acquisition system

Nominations for the ESI International 2006 Contracting Award must be submitted by February 24, 2006. Each nomination must be approved by the head of the contracting activity for government nominations or an appropriate vice president for industry nominations, describe the candidate's accomplishments in detail (but not to exceed three pages) and include a summary of the accomplishment not to exceed 150 words.
